Special Fields of Interest & Research:

Cleft Lip & Palate:

I have special interest in the management of patients with Craniofacial deformity patients, and Cleft lip and palate in particular. There was no cleft lip and palate unit to serve the population of the North of Jordan. During the last 10 years I started to provide clinical services to cleft lip and palate patients. This started by visiting the new born baby in hospital and providing counseling to the parents, followed by making arrangements for primary lip closure, palatal repair and alveolar bone graft etc. With help of other colleagues, especially orthodontists, we managed to form a nucleus for our comprehensive cleft team. In February 2002 we took the advantage of the opening of King Abdullah University Hospital (660 beds) and started establishing “The comprehensive Centre for Cleft lip and Plate Patients’ Care”. There are no other organized comprehensive cleft services in Jordan nor in other countries in the region.

Research grants were obtained to explore several research areas in Cleft Lip and Palate patients. These projects were carried out jointly with master students and colleagues in related specialities. The principle areas of research till the present time include:

1. Dental anomalies in Cleft Lip and Palate patients
2. Congenital anomalies in Cleft Lip and Palate patients
3. Alveolar bone grafting in Cleft Lip and Palate patients
4. Oral microbiology and Oral health status in Cleft Lip and Palate patients
